







MEDICAL CONVOYS

IBF provided more than 600 medical convoys, where more than 395,000 patients were examined and received quality medical health care from diagnose to medication. Our medical convoys are divided into monthly 2-day convoys, weekly 1-day convoys, and specialized convoys.

The foundation has five mobile medical health clinics and equipped vehicles that are used for various medical services.

SATELLITE CLINICS

IBF provides quality medical serves to patients in underprivileged areas through fixed satellite clinics, offering diagnosis, medication, follow ups, and surgeries. Our satellite clinics are equipped with top quality medical equipment including Telemedicine to cover more medical specialties and to enable us to connect with medical specialists in Cairo or abroad from any of our clinics in remote areas.

Our first satellite clinic was launched in Fayoum in 2020 to provide outpatient services and currently IBF operates 3 satellite clinics in different governorates across Egypt and launching more soon.





SATELLITE CLINICS

FAYOUM, BENI SUEF, ASWAN SATELLITE CLINICS

Operating 3 to 5 days per week covering a variety of medical specialties and equipped with Telemedicine for a broader medical coverage as well as a lab, medication, and follow ups with a symbolic fee.

Aswan Satellite Clinic to be launched during Q2 2022 with the same model.

DOWNTOWN CLINIC

Operates weekly for ongoing projects and surgeries referrals and follow ups.















SURGERIES

Surgical cases are referred to surgeries by doctors during our medical convoys or through our Satellite Clinics. The foundation implemented more than 1,200 life changing surgical operations in private hospitals located in Cairo to provide quality medical care.

During the process; from diagnosis to post surgery, there is one contact person assigned from IBF dedicated to the patient through out the whole process, from visiting his home and neighborhood for case validation, to accompanying him to appointments with the surgeon prior surgery for preparations and post surgery for follow ups.





EVENTS MEDICAL COVERAGE

Our foundation supports a range of health & awareness related events, mainly sports and educational events. We provide adequate medical assistance during events. This includes the on-site presence of personnel trained in emergency medical care and emergency treatment.

We work with event organizers to create special events plans prior to the event. Most plans address the type of venue; number of individuals expected to be in attendance; geographical, social and seasonal considerations; emergency medical services capabilities. Small events generally have one or two Mobile Health Clinics, Doctors, and the needed medication.











"IN THE LOVING MEMORY OF"

IBF enables people mourning the loss of dear ones to honour them, by contributing on their behalf to a good cause and to channel their grief in spreading hope to others. This is the how IBF started and is what IBF stands for.

The foundation facilitates an ongoing charity on their behalf through memorial donations for medical convoys, clinics setup, machines, and equipment. People sometimes choose to volunteer which IBF always encourage.







IBF MODEL OVERVIEW


TO BE FLEDGED NATIONWIDE

Our model includes a satellite clinic with a highly skilled medical team, top quality medical equipment including Telemedicine, as well as weekly medical convoys to rural areas to be able to reach underprivileged families, as well as offer follow ups or surgery referrals at the satellite clinic.

The successful model is fully operational in Fayoum and Beni Suef, and our plan is to begin operations in more governorates on a yearly basis - to be fledged nationwide.

Advantages to patients, community, and IBF:

- ✓ Ability to provide services to remote locations increasing reach to underprivileged areas.
- ✓ Increasing access to health care specialists through telemedicine services.
- ✓ Developing local capabilities and talent by providing training and coaching to local doctors at the clinic.
- ✓ Increased sustainability of service with fixed presence and quality service by local team.



IBF maps each governorate and sends a convoy on a weekly basis to different areas to have a complete closure of the each governorate. "OUR CHILDREN, OUR FUTURE" INITIATIVE SPONSORED BY CIB FOUNDATION

Launched in 2019 to support the underprivileged children of Egypt by meeting their medical needs, help them thrive & succeed as individuals in society, & become part of the country's sustainable development. We provide medical care, treatment, & surgeries. So far, more than 62k children were examined and given adequate treatment & surgeries for urgent cases.



"CHILDREN'S WELLNESS" INITIATIVE SPONSORED BY CRÉDIT AGRICOLE FOUNDATION FOR DEVELOPMENT

Launched in December 2020 to deliver quality medical services to orphanages & caretakers, by giving consultation & treatment, raising general health awareness & promoting healthy habits, & follow ups in our Downtown clinic. CAFD also donated a Mobile Health Clinic to IBF to support our ongoing convoys to orphanages.

AWARENESS AND PREVENTION INITIATIVE

IBF launched awareness & prevention campaigns to educate the public about COVID-19, & provided personal protective equipment & vitamins to the most underprivileged families in Fayoum, Giza, Beni Suef & Ismailia. The foundation supported more than 10,522 people & 2,039 families in 43 different villages.

"A HEALTHY EGYPT" INITIATIVE

SPONSORED BY HOUSING AND DEVELOPMENT BANK AND FAISAL ISLAMIC BANK OF EGYPT

Launched in 2019 to support the unprivileged communities in Egypt, in alignment with the presidential initiatives to support citizens' health by early diagnosis of diseases & healthcare accessibility & delivery, together with organizing awareness campaigns to correct popular health misconceptions. This initiative assisted more than 66k beneficiaries through 61 medical convoys.



DIABETES INITIATIVE SPONSORED BY AXA INSURANCE

IBF provided two convoys solely dedicated to the needs of diabetic patients & treatment of diabetes complications, mainly through medical specializations such as internal medicine, orthopedics, ophthalmology & dermatology. The convoys examined 3k patients, as efforts were geared toward early detection of the disease & not neglecting treatment to avoid complications that can impact the diabetic's quality of life in many ways.



TELEMEDICINE MACHINE AND MEDICAL EQUIPMENTS SPONSORED QNB AL AHLI

QNB Alahli sponsored a Telemedicine machine to offer the needed medical services remotely to support the local area. QNB also generously provided medical equipment and supplies for IBF for two consecutive years.



SUCCESS STORIES



AWARENESS AND PREVENTION INITIATIVE SPONSORED EBE BANK

During the spread of Covid-19 virus, EBE Bank launched an awareness and prevention campaign in 43 different villages across Fayoum, Giza, Beni Suef, and Ismailia. This initiative focused on distributing protection equipment along with different vitamins. More than 10,522 individuals were supported along with 2,039 families. Finally, the campaign managed to raise the level of awareness from 40% to 90%.



ORPHANAGES WITH SPECIAL NEEDS INITIATIVE SPONSORED SAIB BANK

IBF collaborated with saib Bank to offer the much needed medical services to special needs children in orphanages around the Greater Cairo area. 8 medical convoys were prepared and organised by IBF to spread hope to orphans with special needs in Greater Cairo during 2021. The medical convoys provided the needed quality medical care and covered different medical specialties.



CHILDREN HEALTH IN QALYUBIA INITIATIVE SPONSORED ABK BANK

IBF partnered with ABK- Egypt to offer medical care for children in Qalyubia by sponsoring 10 medical convoys to provide quality medical care and raise health and nutrition awareness during the second half of 2021.
